Introduction of the Hong Kong Games

The Hong Kong Games (the Games) made its debut in 2007. Since then, this newly introduced local multi-sports event would be held biennially for participation by the 18 districts. The objectives of the Games are to provide districts with more opportunities for sports participation, exchanges and co-operation with a view to facilitating communication and promoting friendship among the 18 districts. Moreover, the Games will help develop closer partnership among all stakeholders, enhance community cohesion, further promote the culture of "Sports for All" and raise the local sports standard.

There were four sports competitions in the 1st Hong Kong Games, including athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball. Each district council fielded its best athletes to participate in the individual and team events and prizes were awarded to the overall champion, the 1st runner-up and the 2nd runner-up of the competition for each sports item above. Moreover, the overall champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games was awarded to the district accumulating the highest total points from the four competitions. A grand opening ceremony and a closing ceremony were held successfully in April and May 2007 respectively making the Games a significant event.

From March to April 2007, elite athletes from respective National Sports Associations were invited to demonstrate their skills and share their experience of participating in competitions with participants of the 18 Districts. This served to help athletes gearing up for the Games and boosting their confidence. Furthermore, activities including 「Making a Guess at the Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games」 and 「Casting a Vote for My Favourite Sporty District」 were organised to encourage participation by the whole community.

In order to encourage the public to involve actively in the Games and strengthen their sense of belonging to the district they live in, "Cheering Team Competition for the 18 Districts" was held and the cheering teams with the best performances and best reflected the local characteristics of the districts they represented were awarded the prizes of the champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up during the closing ceremony.

1st Hong Kong Games Closing cum Prize Presentation Ceremony

Kwai Tsing nets overall championship of 1st Hong Kong Games

Kwai Tsing District is the overall champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games after three weeks of competitions in athletics, badminton, basketball and table tennis, involving 1,287 athletes from 18 districts. The winning district was announced at the Closing and Prize Presentation Ceremony at Hong Kong Park Sports Centre on May 6. The Secretary for Home Affairs, Dr Patrick Ho, congratulated all participating athletes on their dedication and sportsmanship. He also praised the 18 District Councils, the participating units of the Games, for mobilising people within their districts to form and train their teams, thus giving fresh impetus to the development of community relations and community sports. "Apart from promoting a sense of belonging within each district, the Games have also strengthened communication among the 18 districts and enhanced social cohesion, both very conducive to the building of a harmonious society, which carries a special meaning in the 10th anniversary of the establishment of the Hong Kong Administrative Region," Dr Ho said. The 1st Hong Kong Games, the first territory-wide multi-sport games, was one of the major programmes to celebrate the 10th anniversary.

Kwai Tsing not only won the overall championship by accumulating the highest scores from all four sports of the Games but also came first in table tennis and basketball and second in athletics. In men's athletics, Kwai Tsing runners won gold in six of the eight running races. Sha Tin was athletics champion and Tuen Mun was the badminton champion.

In all, 120 medals equally divided between gold, silver and bronze were awarded to athletes in 40 competitive events. True to the spirit of "Sports for All", the youngest participant of the Games was an eight-year-old boy on North District's table tennis team, while the oldest was a 72-year-old lady from Southern District, also a table tennis contestant. At the closing ceremony, awards were also presented to outstanding cheering teams for their performances at the Opening Ceremony on April

21. The cheering team from Central and Western District won both the Best Performance Award and the Best Local Characteristics Award. Other officiating guests at the closing ceremony were the President of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, Mr Timothy Fok; the Permanent Secretary for Home Affairs, Mrs Carrie Lam; the Chairman of the Organising Committee of the 1st Hong Kong Games, Mr Chau How-chen, and the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services, Mr Thomas Chow. During the ceremony, elite table tennis players Ko Lai-chak and Tang Peng played a friendly match with the winning team in men's table tennis doubles. After the Ceremony, Mr Timothy Fok, Mr Chau How-chen and Mr Thomas Chow officiated at two lucky draws to select the winners of the "My Favourite Sporty District" voting game and "Overall Champion" guessing game, community participation events launched in the run-up to the Games. Wan Chai was voted "My Favourite Sporty District", winning 10,710 of the more than 53,748 votes cast. A total of 48,767 people had entered the "Overall Champion" guessing game.

1st Hong Kong Games open

The 1st Hong Kong Games were officially opened by the Chief Executive, Mr Donald Tsang, at Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground on April 21, marking a major step forward in the development of community sports in Hong Kong. Hong Kong's first territory-wide multi-sport games are also one of the major programmes to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.



The 18 District Councils, the participating units of the Games, are fielding 1,287 athletes to compete in four sports - athletics (445), badminton (230), basketball (372) and table tennis (240). The athletes marched into Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground tonight, led by a Hong Kong Games flag held by local elite athletes, including Wong Kam Po, Yip Pui Yin, Angie Tsang, Sze Hang Yu, Tang Yik Chun, Lui Chor Wai, Chiu Chung Hei and Lee Ho Ching.

Joining the march were the cheering teams from the districts, all trying to outshine each other with their colourful outfits and choreographed movements. Addressing the audience and athletes, the Secretary for Home Affairs, Dr Patrick Ho, said the biennial territory-wide games would be an excellent vehicle for promoting local sports culture.

"Not only will the Games offer more opportunities for participation in sports at the community level, they will also help identify athletes with high potential. "Closer partnership will be forged between the sports organisations involved and cohesion within each district strengthened," Dr Ho said.



After Mr Tsang declared the 1st Hong Kong Games open, the national flag, Hong Kong SAR flag and Hong Kong Games flag were raised as the Hong Kong Police Band played the national anthem. Other officiating guests included the Honorary President of the Organising Committee of the 1st Hong Kong Games, Mr Timothy Fok; the Chairman of the Organising Committee, Mr Chau How-chen; the Permanent Secretary for Home Affairs, Mrs Carrie Lam; the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services, Mr Thomas Chow and the chairmen and representatives of the 18 District Councils.



The ceremony reached its climax as Chinese Olympic gold medallists Xu Haifeng and Deng Yaping accompanied Hong Kong's Asian Games medallist Wong Kam-po and a Hong Kong Games participant as they lighted the torch of the Games with a shooting flame. There followed an hour-long

celebration in songs and dances featuring local pop stars like Eason Chan, Joey Yung, Leo Ku and Justin Lo, mainland musical ensemble Orchids 18 and lion and dragon dance troupes.

The 1st Hong Kong Games are organised by the Sports Commission and co-ordinated by its Community Sports Committee with support from the 18 District Councils, the Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, relevant National Sports Associations and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.



Preliminary competitions started in early April and finals will be held from tomorrow (April 22) to May 5 at various sports venues of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. The grand prize presentation and closing ceremony of the Games will be held on May 6 at Hong Kong Park Sports Centre.

To help athletes gear up for the Games and boost their confidence, Organising Committee held four demonstration and exchange sessions. The "Athletics Elite Demonstration and Exchange" was staged at Tsing Yi Sports Ground on 9 April 2007.

Experienced coaches and elite athletes from the Hong Kong Amateur Athletic Association, including TANG Hon-sing, Hong Kong Male 110m and 400m Hurdle record-holder, CHAN Ho-yee, Hong Kong Female 4x100m Relay record-holder, LEUNG Yee-mei, Hong Kong Female Hammer-throw record-holder, CHAN Chin-wan, LI Wai-lam, CHAN Genis, LO Ngai-fung, NG Chit-wing, CHUNG Chi-hang, HUI Kin-shing, TSUI Yun-yung, CHUNG Ka-bong, LEUNG Hoi-kit, YEUNG Hon-mo, WONG Man-yiu and LEE Ka-shun, gave participants a brush-up on basic techniques and demonstrated their skills in the seven events including sprint, hurdle, high jump, long jump, discus, javelin and shot put.

To help athletes gear up for the Games and boost their confidence, "Badminton Elite Demonstration and Exchange" has been held at Hong Kong Park Sports

Nine elite badminton players from the Hong Kong Badminton Association Ltd., WONG Wai-hong, CHAN Yan-kit, WONG Wing-ki, HUNG Yuk-wong, YIP Pui-yin, CHAU Hoi-wah, WONG Sin-yee, WONG Man-ching and MONG Kwan-yi, demonstrated their skills and shared their experience with about 100 participants from the 18 districts. An ex-player of Hong Kong Special Administration Region Team, Mr TAM Lok-tin acted as the commentator and introduced individual basic training techniques and competition strategies on singles and doubles events. Athletes who attended the demonstration and exchange session said they had benefited a great deal from it.

First HK Games writes a new page in HK sports annals



A new page in the sports annals of Hong Kong will be written on April 21 when the 1st Hong Kong Games opens with a spectacular ceremony at Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground.

Chinese Olympic gold medallists Xu Haifeng (shooting, 1984) and Deng Yaping (table tennis, 1992 and 1996) will attend the ceremony as special guests.

This was disclosed by the chairman of the Organising Committee of the Games, Mr Chau How-chen, at a press conference today on March 29.

Mr Chau said the ceremony would feature the march-in of some 1,200 athletes from the 18 districts, a cheering team competition, the lighting of the torch, pyrotechnics, as well as performances by the mainland musical ensemble China Flowers and local pop stars like Eason Chan, Joey Yung, Leo Ku and Justin Lo.

Free admission tickets for the opening ceremony will be distributed at all District Leisure Services Offices of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department from April 12 on a first-come, first-served basis. Each person may obtain two tickets at most.

Competitions in the four sports of the Games - athletics, badminton, basketball and table tennis - will be held until May 6, with the 18 District Councils as participating units.

The 18 District Councils have fielded 1,265 athletes - 436 in athletics, 229 in badminton, 359 in basketball and 241 in table tennis.

At today's press conference, representatives of the District Councils drew lots to decide the fixture of the team games (files attached).

Also announced at the press conference were the interim results of a guessing game and a voting game launched earlier this month, which showed Central and Western to be the district most people think would be the Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games and also the district most likely to be voted "My Favourite Sporty District".

But the guess and voting games are continuing and the public can still make their guesses, cast their votes and win Swiss Buler watches of up to \$5,000 apiece.

Entry forms for the guessing game and voting tickets for the voting game are available at all District Leisure Services Offices and sports centres of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. Completed entry forms and tickets should be put into collection boxes at those places on or before April 21. Multiple entries are allowed.

Hong Kong Games launched to promote community sports



The 1st Hong Kong Games will be held from April 21 to May 6 to promote sports in the community. Teams representing the 18 District Councils will participate in the Games, which will be one of the major programmes to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

Speaking at a ceremony in Kowloon Park today on February 15 to launch the 1st Hong Kong Games, the Secretary for Home Affairs, Dr Patrick Ho, said it was hoped that the first territory-wide multi-sport games would be a platform for participation, exchange and co-operation in sports at the community level.

"We hope the Games will strengthen communication and friendship among the 18 districts, forge closer partnership among all parties involved, enhance cohesiveness within communities, and promote our citizens' interest in sports and their sense of belonging to their communities," Dr Ho said.

Together with the President of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, Mr Timothy Fok; Chairman of the Organising Committee of the 1st Hong Kong Games, Mr Chau How-chen; and Director of Leisure and Cultural Services, Mr Thomas Chow, Dr Ho unveiled the emblem of the Games.

The idea to hold Hong Kong's first ever territory-wide multi-sport games was endorsed by the Sports Commission last August as part of a package of initiatives to promote community sports. The proposal is supported by the 18 District Councils and the Games will be held biennially from 2007 onwards.


The Games are organised by the Sports Commission and co-ordinated by its Community Sports Committee with support from the 18 District Councils, the Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, relevant National Sports Associations, the Home Affairs Bureau and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

An organising committee to plan the Games was formed last year under the Community Sports Committee and the chairmanship of Mr Chau.

The Games cover four most popular community sports, namely, athletics, basketball, badminton and table tennis.

The 18 District Councils will be the participating units. The councils will work in collaboration with the respective district sports associations and the District Leisure Services Offices of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department to select athletes to represent the districts in the Games.

To enhance public awareness of the 1st Hong Kong Games and to involve the whole community in the event, the public are invited to guess which district will be the overall champion and to cast votes for "My Favourite Sporty District". Attractive prizes will be awarded to lucky winners.



At the ceremony, Mr Chau said local elite athletes would conduct experience sharing sessions for Games participants, not just to prepare them better for the Games but also to raise the community's interests in sports.

The 18 District Councils signified their full support to the Games with their representatives making a pledge at today's ceremony.

A spectacular opening ceremony will be held at Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground on April 21. A closing and prize presentation ceremony will be held at Hong Kong Park Sports Centre on May 6.

In between, the competitions will take place at Hong Kong Park Sports Centre, Kowloon Park Sports Centre, Tsing Yi Sports Ground and Cornwall Street Squash & Table Tennis Centre.

Participating Units' Points to Note

The 1st Hong Kong Games (the Games) will be held from April to May 2007 at various sports venues under the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD).

Participating Units

The participating units are the 18 District Councils in Hong Kong.

Eligibility

1. Participants should be holders of valid "Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card".
2. Any athlete who has been selected to represent Hong Kong between 2004 and 2007 in athletics, table tennis, badminton or basketball in the Olympic Games, the Asian Games, the East Asian Games, the National Games of the People's Republic of China, the National Intercity Games of the People's Republic of China, the World Championships or the Asian Championships is not eligible to participate in the same sport in the Hong Kong Games.
3. Each athlete can only represent one district in the Games and should be nominated by the district council he/she represents. He/she should participate in the Games in the capacity of that district council.
4. Participants must reside in the district they represent (Proof of Place of Residence should be provided).
 - a. "Local residents" refers to the people who reside within the district boundary of a respective district. The district boundary of the respective district is defined in the Maps showing the Constituency Boundaries for the District Councils Election. For checking the district boundary of a respective district, please browse the website of the Electoral Affairs Commission (http://www.eac.gov.hk/en/distco/2007dc_map.htm).
 - b. "Proof of Place of Residence" refers to the original copy of the valid documentary proof bearing the name of the participant, such as:
 - i. Statements (such as rates demand note, bills for electricity and water charges, monthly bank statement or telephone bill) issued by public utilities/ commercial organisations or banks within the latest three months;
 - ii. Student's handbook (if the student handbook cannot be produced, the documents stated in (i) bearing the name of his/her parent(s) together with his/her birth certificate may be provided);
 - iii. Declaration of place of residence issued by the Home Affairs Department; or
 - iv. Mortgage statement, tenancy agreement or resident card.
 - c. Whenever necessary, the Organiser can ask the district that the participants represent to submit the "Proof of Place of Residence" in respect of the participants so as to prove that they reside in that district.

5. Participants must meet the eligibility requirements mentioned above. If it is found that the participants fail to meet the eligibility requirements or represent more than one district, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify the participants from the Games. If they have already taken part in the Games, the results achieved by the participants and the team they represent in the competition will be cancelled.
6. Participants in the athletics shall be aged 16 or above and those in the basketball competition shall be aged 12 or above while participants of all ages are welcome to enter the table tennis and badminton competitions.

Sports and Awards

There are four sports, namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball, in the 1st Hong Kong Games and the prizes listed below will be awarded to winners.

1. Prizes will be awarded to the Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each event.
2. Prizes will be awarded to the Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each of the competitions, namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball. The scoring system is set out as follows:

The top eight winners of each event can score 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5 points respectively, i.e. the Champion can score 13 points, the 1st runner-up can score 11 points and so forth. The top three districts accumulating the highest total points will be awarded the Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of the respective competition.

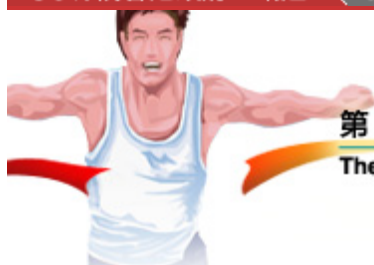
3. The prize for the "Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games" will be awarded to the district accumulating the highest total points from the 4 competitions, namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball.

Enrolment Method

The 18 District Councils will discuss with the district sports associations and the District Leisure Services Offices of the LCSD to determine the method of selecting athletes to enter the competitions. The aim is to select the athletes/teams who meet the eligibility requirements and have the best records as the representatives of their own districts to participate in the competitions.

The person in charge of the competitions in each district should verify the eligibility of each participant in accordance with the eligibility requirements stated above and return the completed "Enrolment Form" to the Major Events Section of the LCSD (Address: 2/F., Leisure and Cultural Services Headquarters, 1-3 Pai Tau Street, Sha Tin, New Territories; Fax number: 2634 0786) on or before 1 March 2007.

Scoring System for Selecting the Overall Champion

There will be the "Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up" prizes for each sport (namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball). These prizes will be awarded to the top three districts that have accumulated the highest total points from the competition of each sport above. The district accumulating the highest total points from all the competitions, namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball events, will be awarded the prize of the "Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games". The scoring system for the prizes is set out as follows:

The Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up of each sport

The top eight winners of each sport can score points for the districts they represent in the following order. From the Champion to the seventh runner-up, each will score 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5 points respectively, i.e. the Champion can score 13 points, the 1st runner-up can score 11 points and so forth. Among all events, the points scored by all participants representing each district will be added together, and the top three districts accumulating the highest total points will be awarded the "Overall Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up" of the respective sports item. If two or more districts score the same highest points, the one that holds more first places will win; and if they hold the same number of first places, the one holding more second places will win. The same method applies until the overall winning places are determined. If all the results are the same with districts winning the same points and holding the same positions, the districts involved will be awarded the same prize.

The Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games

The positions of the top eight winning districts of each sport (namely athletics, table tennis, badminton and basketball) will be determined by the scoring system mentioned above. The Champion (i.e. the "Overall Champion" of the respective competition, for example, the "Overall Champion" of the table tennis competition) will score 13 points, and the first to seventh runners-up will score 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5 points respectively. The district accumulating the highest total points from all of the four competitions will be awarded the prize for the "Overall Champion of the 1st Hong Kong Games".
